Online pre-registration part 2 for courses to be taken for Second Semester 2019-2020 will be on **January 3 (Friday)**, 4 (Saturday), and 6 (Monday), 2020, from 8:00 am to 9:00 pm.

Students can view their grades for First Semester, 2019-2020 once the instructors post the grades. Changes can be made in the pre-registered courses (add, cancel and change).

For students who failed to pre-register on November 19 to 22, 2019 and for those students who want to make changes in their enlisted courses, pre-registration can be done according to the following appointments:

Reminders:

- 1) Consult with your adviser if you have plans to change your plan of course work before encoding courses on the Shopping Cart.
- 2) Slots enlisted in during pre-registration will be the confirmed slots for Second Semester, 2019-2020 enrollment.
- 3) If a failing grade is incurred in the prerequisite course taken during the First Semester 2019-2020, delete the pre-registered higher course and re-enlist the prerequisite course for Second Semester, 2019-2020.
- 4) Students with unsettled accountabilities from the previous semesters (SLB outstanding loans), should settle their accounts or accomplish a promissory note, **not later than January 13, 2020** (Monday).
- 5) Students not eligible for the free tuition and other school fees program with no outstanding accountabilities but will not be able to pay the matriculation fee for Second Semester 2019-2020 due to financial problems, are advised to avail of the student loan (SLB) or file a promissory note not later than January 13, 2020 (Monday).
- 6) Students with scholastic delinquency:
 - Students with status of Double Probation/Dismissed or Permanently Disqualified should apply for readmission not later than January 3, 2020 (Friday). Failure to do so will result to the removal of pre-registered subjects from their account.
